### Voluntary Security Camera Registration Program

This program is designed to partner the community with the Magnolia Police Department in preventing/solving crimes that may have been recorded on private security cameras.

The Magnolia Police Department is requesting any residents, businesses, and organizations within the Borough that have security surveillance cameras complete the form below.

Registering video cameras is voluntary. The Magnolia Police Department will not have access to your security system. If a crime, or suspicious activity occurs in your neighborhood, your security system may have recorded evidence and useful information which could help the police solve/reduce suspicious activity.

In the event of a crime/suspicious activity occurring in your neighborhood, a member of the Magnolia Police Department would contact you and ask if your surveillance system recorded the incident. Registering your system would help expedite getting information and assist with investigations.
