

RESOLUTION 2020-115

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF A SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE 2020 BUDGET OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A.40A:4-87 (CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948) BEING AWARDED \$8,621.07 BY FY2020 CLEAN COMMUNITIES GRANT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia has received a grant award in the amount of Eight thousand six hundred twenty-one dollars and seven cents (\$8,621.07) Reserve for FY2020 Clean Communities Grant to be used for Clean Communities and wishes to amend its 2020 Budget to include this amount as a revenue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Magnolia hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget for the year 2020 in the amount of Eight thousand six hundred twenty-one dollars and seven cents (\$8,621.07) which item is now available as revenue under the caption of:




