WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia would like to enter into a State Contract agreement with Home Depot, contract number 18-FLEET-00234, for the purchase of:



WHEREAS, Home Depot is now the contractor for the purchase of the equipment; and


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the funds for this purchase through the capital budget.

ADOPTED, at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey held on October 6, 2021.




