**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
MAGNOLIA APPOINTING MUNICIPAL CLERK**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-133, each municipality located within the State of New Jersey is required to appoint a Municipal Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, Daneen D. Fuss has resigned from the beforementioned position effective October 29, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body may appoint a person who meets the requirements per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-133 to fill the position commencing on the date of the vacancy; and

**WHEREAS**, Jenai Johnson, a Registered Municipal Clerk of the State of New Jersey, meets the qualifications; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia that Jenai Johnson is hereby appointed as Municipal Clerk effective November 1, 2021, with term expiring December 31, 2021.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, Jenai Johnson will receive a \$500 stipend per month, in addition to a wage of \$45 per hour for up to 10 hours per week.
