

**RESOLUTION 2021-183**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA  
AUTHORIZING A 100% DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION, CANCELLATION, AND  
REFUND OF OVERPAYMENT OF TAXES**

**WHEREAS**, Ronald D Persinger, the owner of the property located at 240 Lafayette Avenue, Block 3.13, Lot 11, has applied for a full property tax exemption as a 100% Disabled Veteran; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Assessor for the Borough of Magnolia has reviewed and approved said application as qualifying for the tax exemption as of October 18, 2021 which is authorized under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and

**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Tax Collector has authorized the cancellation of taxes as of the effective date of his disability, May 24, 2021 as per the Department of Veterans Affairs, in the amount of \$3,629.76; and


**WHEREAS**, Corelogic has paid all taxes for 2021 on behalf of the mortgage company PennyMac; and


**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Tax Collector has certified that the cancellation of taxes has caused an overpayment and is requesting a refund be made to Corelogic in the amount of \$3,629.76 under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that a full property tax exemption is hereby authorized to Ronald D Persinger as a 100% Disabled Veteran on 240 Lafayette Avenue, Block 3.13, Lot 11.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia authorizes the cancellation and refund of tax overpayment in the amount of \$3,629.76 to Corelogic.
