**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION  
OF MUNICIPAL RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION AND  
DESIGNATING OFFICIAL THEREFORE**

**WHEREAS**, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c 102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and expand existing programs; and,

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and,

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including, but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and,


**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2020 recycling tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of this municipality of recycling and indicate the assent of Borough Council of the Borough of Magnolia, Camden County, State of New Jersey that the Borough of Magnolia to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and,

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure that the application is properly completed and timely filed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Magnolia hereby endorsed the submission of a Municipal Recycling Tonnage Grant Application

of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Recycling and designates Paul Sexton, Foreman of Public Works to ensure that the said Application is properly filed.
