**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A STRATEGIC PLAN FOR THE MUNICIPAL
ALLIANCE GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023**

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth, and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Borough recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Borough further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuse in our community; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Borough has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Camden.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that that following is hereby recognized:

1. The Borough Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Magnolia Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year 2023 in the amount of:


