

**RESOLUTION 2021-87**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA  
AUTHORIZING A REFUND OF A HOMESTEAD BENEFIT CREDIT**

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Collector has certified that three refunds should be issued due to a Homestead Benefit Credit being credited to a property, instead of the property owner; and

**WHEREAS**, State of New Jersey issued the following properties Homestead Rebates on the past, and most recently on March 22, 2021:

1.13/3 – 102 E. Washington Ave – \$481.51

2.03/7.01 – 125 W. Lincoln Ave – \$437.67

8.05/24 – 724 W. Jackson Ave – \$452.67

**WHEREAS**, in each case, each property owner is the recipient of a 100% Totally Disabled Veteran/Surviving Spouse Property Tax Exemption, and is exempt from paying property taxes, and this credit is rolling over each quarter, and;


**WHEREAS**, these credits should be returned to the homeowners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by Mayor and Borough Council to authorize the refund of the Homestead Benefit Credits belonging to the above properties in the amount of \$1,371.85.
