**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
AUTHORIZING SERVICE AGREEMENT – BOROUGH HALL IMPROVEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia has a need to acquire General Contractor William Obert, NJ Lic. No. 13VH004218000, as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer's Finance Clerk, under his direction, has determined and certified in writing that the determination of value may or may not exceed \$16,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is until construction is completed on the catwalk in the Attic of Borough Hall located at 438 W. Evesham Ave., Magnolia, NJ, 08049; and

WHEREAS, William Obert, has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that the company has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Magnolia in the previous year, and that the contract will prohibit William Obert from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, William Obert, 120 Forrest Avenue, Runnemede, NJ 08078 is hereby retained to provide services as beforementioned for an amount that may or may not exceed \$16,500.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes General Contractor William Obert, NJ Lic. No. 13VH004218000, to enter into a contract with the Borough of Magnolia as attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value be placed on file with this resolution; and


BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that:

1. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as "Non-Fair & Open" in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) because services are for an amount that may or may not exceed \$16,500.00. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to sign the contract.
2. A copy of the Resolution as well as the contract shall be placed on file with the Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Magnolia.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award as required by law.


