**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA  
AUTHORIZING NJ COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT #T1372 UTILIZING STATE  
CONTRACT 88695 – MULTI-TEMP MECHANICAL, INC**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia has a need to acquire Multi-Temp Mechanical as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer's Finance Clerk, under his direction, has determined and certified in writing that the determination of value may or may not exceed \$51,711.70; and

**WHEREAS**, the anticipated term of this contract is until the repair and/or replacement of the Air Conditioning System is completed at the Donald E. Wilson Community Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Multi-Temp Mechanical, has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Multi-Temp Mechanical, has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Magnolia in the previous year, and that the contract will prohibit Multi-Temp Mechanical from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, and

**WHEREAS**, Multi-Temp Mechanical, 1000 Delsea Drive, Westville, NJ 08093 is hereby retained to provide services as beforementioned for an amount that may or may not exceed \$51,711.70.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes Multi-Temp Mechanical, to enter into a contract with the Borough of Magnolia as attached hereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value be placed on file with this resolution; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that:

1. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as "Non-Fair & Open" in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) because services are for an amount that may or may not exceed \$51,711.70. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to sign the contract.
2. A copy of the Resolution as well as the contract shall be placed on file with the Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Magnolia.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award as required by law.


