

RESOLUTION 2022-108

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEWLY REVISED MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY
OPERATIONS PLAN**

WHEREAS, P.L. 1989, c. 222 mandates the development and approval of Emergency Operations Plans for all municipalities, counties and the State; and

WHEREAS, an Emergency Operations Plan will allow the Borough of Magnolia (“the Borough”) in correlation with its Office of Emergency Management to better prepare and manage jurisdiction-wide emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Borough must submit an Emergency Operations Plan through the County Office of Emergency management to the State Office of Emergency Management for initial review and approval, and will require recertification every four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is in receipt of an Emergency Operations Plan and a request from its Office of Emergency Management for formal adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Borough maintains a Camden County, Intra-County Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement between the County, the Borough and Participating Units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that it hereby authorizes and adopts a newly revised Municipal Emergency Operations Plan.



BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Borough Emergency Management Coordinator is hereby authorized to send a certified copy of this Resolution and the Revised Emergency Operations Plan to the Camden County Office of Emergency Management.


