

RESOLUTION 2022-123

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FIREFIGHTER GRANT
APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant (“Firefighter Grant”) supports local and regional fire department firefighters by ensuring they have access to funding to purchase appropriate gear, clothing, cleaning supplies and sanitization equipment to combat the threats of the COVID-19 virus and the strain of emergency fire requests on communities confronting the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia wishes to apply for the Firefighter Grant, offered by New Jersey’s Department of Community Affairs (NJDCA), for approximately \$75,000.00 for the purchase of the following equipment:

- Cleaning and advanced cleaning equipment such as a fire gear extractor/washer and dryer, etc.
- Protective clothing (numerous turnout gear ensembles: coats, liners, pants, gloves, helmets, flash hoods, and boots, etc.)
- Electrostatic sprayers, foggers, misters, or vaporizers for surface disinfection
- Oxygen equipment such as tanks, respirators, and masks
- COVID-19 sanitization training program and disinfection safety course

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, does hereby authorize the submission of the Firefighter Grant application for approximately \$75,000.00 for the purpose of combating the threats of the COVID-19 virus and the strain of emergency fire requests on communities confronting the pandemic.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough of Magnolia recognizes and accepts the NJDCA may offer a lesser amount and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the NJDCA, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the NJDCA, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the Borough of Magnolia and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Fire Chief of the Borough of Magnolia is authorized to sign the application, and that they or their successors in said titles are authorized to sign the agreement, and any other documents necessary in connection therewith.


