MAGNOLIA APPOINTING A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER**



**WHEREAS**, the P.A.C.O. will be the point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the legal requirements of the Equal Employment Opportunity Monitoring Program; and


**WHEREAS**, the P.A.C.O. is responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to equal employment regarding both the public agency and its service providers.


