**WHEREAS**, there exists a need to amend Resolution 2022-153; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 2022-153, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia determined the firearm used by Patrolman Cocchi has no future use or value in retirement and must be returned to the Borough of Magnolia on or before the acknowledged date of retirement effective September 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2022-153 is hereby amended to reflect that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia has determined the firearm used by Patrolman Cocchi has no future use or value to the Borough of Magnolia; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past the Magnolia Police Department has presented retired members with their firearm for their loyalty and devotion to the Police Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes the official transfer of ownership of the firearm used by Patrolman Robert Cocchi to Patrolman Robert Cocchi effective September 1, 2022.


