**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING THE INSERTION OF A SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE
IN THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A.
40A:4-87 (CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,426.62 AS A RECIPIENT
OF THE FY2022 PATRICK LEAHY BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP (BVP)
GRANT**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia has received a grant award in the amount of \$1,426.62 for FY2022 Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) to be used for the purchase of bulletproof vest for our Police Department and wishes to amend its 2022 Budget to include this amount as revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Borough of Magnolia hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget for the year 2022 in the amount of \$1,426.62 which item is now available as revenue under the caption of:




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above is the result of monies received from the State of New Jersey.


