**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN
CONTRACT FOR SPECIAL PROJECT ENGINEER**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia has a need to acquire Special Project Engineering Services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition may or may not exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is 1 year; and

WHEREAS, Environmental Resolutions, Inc., 815 East Gate Drive, Suite 103, Mount Laurel, NJ 08054 has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Environmental Engineers, has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Magnolia in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the Environmental Engineers from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, and

WHEREAS, Environmental Resolutions, Inc., is hereby retained to provide professional services as described above for an amount that may or may not to exceed \$17,500.00 plus reimbursable expense for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia authorizes Environmental Resolutions, Inc. to enter into a contract with Borough of Magnolia as described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value be placed on file with this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that:

1. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-5(1)(a) because it is for services performed by persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are authorized to sign the contract.
2. A copy of this resolution as well as the contract shall be placed on file with the Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Magnolia.
3. The Borough Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award as required by law.
