**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND REPLACEMENT OF BOILER, SAFETY
COMPONENTS, OPERATING CONTROLS, AND AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT
SYSTEM UTILIZING STATE CONTRACT 88695**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11 et seq., may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under any contract or contracts for such goods or services entered on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the State Contract alleviates the need for competitive price bidding by the Borough of Magnolia and, thereby, complies with all bid specifications and bid requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia has the need to purchase and install a new boiler system with safety components, operating controls, and air purifiers; and


WHEREAS, it is recommended that the utilization of the NJ Cooperative Pricing agreement T1372 Contract Number 88695 represents the best price available to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia wishes to enter into contract with Multi-Temp Mechanical, Inc., for a total cost of \$57,634.17; and


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has determined that sufficient funds are available.


