**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA APPOINTING SHELLEY WILSON TO SERVE ON COUNCIL UNTIL
THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, Councilman Richard Krause was reelected to serve on the Council of the Borough of Magnolia on November 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Richard Krause, by letter dated January 3, 2022, relinquished his seat on the Council of the Borough of Magnolia effective January 5, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the resignation created a vacancy in the office; and

WHEREAS, Shelley Wilson, by knowledge, is qualified to fill the vacancy and hold the office as Councilwoman of the Borough of Magnolia; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:16-3f and N.J.S.A. 40A:16-7, a vacancy in the office of a Council Member is filled by a majority vote of the remaining members on Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The resignation of Councilman Richard Krause, effective January 5, 2022, is hereby acknowledged, and accepted.
2. Shelley Wilson is hereby appointed as Councilwoman of the Borough of Magnolia with an annual salary of \$8,234.35 and shall serve until her successor is elected following the next general election to be held on November 8, 2022.


