**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA APPROVING CHANGE ORDER #1 – R.J. WALSH ASSOCIATES, INC. –
FUEL PUMPS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2021, the Borough of Magnolia adopted Resolution 2021-143, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c), purchasing fuel pumps for the Department of Public Works from R.J. Walsh Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$20,385.45 per state contract #A42268; and


WHEREAS, there exists a need for additional work on the fuel pumps, which was not noticed in the preliminary assessment, in order to bring said fuel pumps up to code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds in the amount of \$3,910.90 from account #C-04-55-837-902.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that Change Order #1 for an increase of \$3,910.90 to the original contract price of \$20,385.45 to R.J. Walsh Associates, Inc., for additional work on the fuel pumps for the Department of Public Works, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the new contract price is \$24,296.35.


