**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA WAIVING FEES**

WHEREAS, Bach Associates has been coordinating with the Department of Public Works regarding a sinkhole caused by a sewer lateral penetrating a corrugated metal storm pipe on Ashland Avenue in Magnolia, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Bach Associates prepared a quote packet, and solicited quotes for the project titled "Ashland Avenue Sinkhole Repairs;" and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia awarded the contract for the before-mentioned project to Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC in the amount of \$27,200.00 at a Work Session Meeting held on January 20, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC and Bach Associates are in the process of coordinating project startup; and


WHEREAS, American Water Works will be carrying out a project at 518 Ashland Avenue, Magnolia, NJ 08049, for which they have requested from the Borough of Magnolia all road opening and plumbing permit fees be waived as a result of the Ashland Avenue Sinkhole Repairs project subsequently occurring after their project at 518 Ashland Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that all road opening and plumbing permit fees be waived for American Water Works as a result of the Ashland Avenue Sinkhole Repairs project subsequently occurring after their project at 518 Ashland Avenue.


