**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA
REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR UNIFORM FIRE
SAFETY ACT PENALTY MONEYS REQUIRED BY N.J.S.A. 52:27D-192 ET SEQ. AND
N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.12A(b)**

WHEREAS, prior approval from the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is required for a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and


WHEREAS, the Uniform Fire Safety Act Penalty Moneys Trust Fund provides for receipt of budget appropriated funds pursuant to N.J.A.C 5:70-2.12A(b) and N.J.S.A. 52:27d-192 et seq. by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Fire Safety Act Penalty Moneys Trust Fund (N.J.S.A. 52:27D-192 et seq.) are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement(s).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of the Fire Safety Act Penalty Moneys Trust Fund pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-192 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.12A(b).
2. The Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Magnolia is hereby directed to forward two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.


