**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING A NJ COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT  
UTILIZING STATE CONTRACT 88695 – MULTI-TEMP MECHANICAL, INC**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11 et seq., may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under any contract or contracts for such goods or services entered on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Contract alleviates the need for competitive price bidding by the Borough of Magnolia and, thereby, complies with all bid specifications and bid requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia has the need to enter into a Planned Service Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended that the utilization of the NJ Cooperative Pricing Agreement T1372 Contract #88695 represents the best price available to the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia wishes to enter into a one-year contract with Multi-Temp Mechanical, Inc., for a total cost of \$10,236.00; and


**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available.
