**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING A REFUND TO THE TREASURER OF THE STATE OF
NEW JERSEY, DIVISION OF SUSTAINABLE WASTE MANAGEMENT, FOR THE
OVERPAYMENT OF THE FY2019 RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c. 102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, January 5, 2022, Resolution 2022-26 was adopted authorizing submission of the municipal recycling tonnage grant application and designating official therefore; and


WHEREAS, due to a clerical error, the Borough of Magnolia received a surplus of funds in the amount of \$87,817.96; and

WHEREAS, a refund has been deemed necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that a refund in the amount of \$87,817.96 be made payable to the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey, Division of Sustainable Waste Management, 401 E State Street, Trenton, NJ 08625, due to the overpayment of the FY2019 Recycling Tonnage Grant.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to issue said refund.
