

**RESOLUTION 2022-84**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING GENERATOR MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia requires a maintenance agreement for preventative services related to its emergency generator; and

**WHEREAS**, at a minimum, a generator should be serviced by a professional at least once a year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a), does not require competitive bidding for this position as the agreement is not anticipated to exceed \$17,500.00; and

**WHEREAS**, GenServe, LLC is qualified and fully able to perform the services requested per the attached preventative maintenance check list; and

**WHEREAS**, beginning May 1, 2022, the beforementioned company will provide preventative maintenance services to the Borough's generator(s) effective for one year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Certified Public Works Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with GenServe, LLC for generator preventative maintenance services for one year beginning May 1, 2022, amount not to exceed \$17,500.00.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, a copy of said agreement is available for review upon request in the Municipal Clerk's Office.


