**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MAGNOLIA  
AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACT FOR ALARM  
SYSTEMS UPDATE AND MONITORING SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Magnolia has a need to acquire an alarm systems update and monitoring services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer's Finance Clerk, under his direction, has determined and certified in writing that the determination of value may or may not exceed \$1,176.74; and

**WHEREAS**, Garden State Security Group, LLC, has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that no reportable contributions were made to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Magnolia in the previous year, and that the contract will prohibit Garden State Security Group, LLC, from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

**WHEREAS**, Garden State Security Group, LLC, 41 S Route 73, Building 1, Suite 204, Hammonton, NJ 08037, is hereby retained to provide services as beforementioned for an amount that may or may not exceed \$1,176.74.00 for the period retroactively commencing on January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes Garden State Security Group, LLC, to enter into a contract with the Borough of Magnolia as attached hereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value be placed on file with this resolution; and


**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that:

1. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as "Non-Fair & Open" in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(l)(a) because services are for an amount that may or may not exceed \$1,176.74. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to sign the contract.
2. A copy of the Resolution as well as the contract shall be placed on file with the Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Magnolia.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award as required by law.


