**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
MAGNOLIA AUTHORIZING A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION,
CANCELLATION OF TAXES, AND REFUND OF OVERPAYMENT OF TAXES**

WHEREAS, the owner of the property known as Block 5.01, Lot 49, at 119 Lapierre Ave., Rudolph A Mickles, has applied for a property tax exemption as a Totally Disabled Veteran on January 18, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved said application as qualifying for the tax exemption authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and


WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has authorized the cancellation of the taxes as of the date of the application, January 18, 2023, as per the Department of Veterans Affairs, in the amount of \$2,586.82; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has certified that the cancellation of taxes has caused an overpayment and is requesting a refund in the amount of \$1,150.93 be made to Wells Fargo Real Estate Tax pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that a tax exemption is hereby granted on Block 5.01, Lot 49, 119 Lapierre Ave., and authorize the cancellation of taxes in the total amount of \$2,586.82.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Magnolia, authorize a refund of tax overpayment in the amount of \$1,150.93 be made to Wells Fargo Real Estate Tax.


